Real Political Reform:

TD's are paid far too much money and expenses. We need to reduce their wages to those of an average worker. Ministers and senior civil servants must be held personally responsible for decisions they make. The Dáil needs to sit 5 days a week. The Seanad needs to be abolished and local councils need to be given greater powers to act and be properly funded to provide vital services.

Health & Educational Equality

Our current dysfunctional health system costs €14.1 Billion every year. This kind of money could provide a universal health care system for all. We need to stop subsidising private health care and tackle the scandalous pay rates of the consultants.

It is ridiculous that we spend €100 million a year to subsidise private fee paying schools while many of our school children sit in prefabs or lose their special needs teachers because of cutbacks. This has to stop. There should be no privileged elite in Ireland. All children should be treated equally and all children should have the opportunity to go on to third level. The Education of our young people is the future of this country.

Real Public Sector Reform;

Changes must start at the top. Senior civil servants and management must be held accountable. While reform is necessary and long overdue, Fianna Fail and Fine Gael are only interested in attacking ordinary workers. Jobs and services for the public must be protected.

Asset Seizure from Financial Criminals:
